Students need **Paired Test Scores** to earn **Payment Points**

Paired scores include a **pretest** and a **posttest**.

The **pretest** is the first valid test of the school year a student takes in a subject or subject area (modality). There is only one pretest each year in a given subject or modality. **Posttests** are all subsequent tests a student takes in the same subject or modality.

(WIA Advisors may alter test assignments.)

(Letters A, B, C and D in parenthesis are test levels.)

***Depending on the pretest scale score, a higher level test may be required for the posttest.**
